

8 Day Yukon River Guided Canoeing Adventure

8 Day/7 nights Whitehorse round trip

Are you ready for an adventure that leads you into one of the world most remarkable wilderness regions? If yes, come and explore with us Canada's Yukon and relive the Gold Rush of 1898.

This tour comprises a 6 day current assisted canoe trip paddling over 300km down Lake Laberge and the Yukon River from Whitehorse to Carmacks.

We follow the trail of the gold rush history, explore several abandoned settlements and constantly find relics from the historic gold rush trail.

We set up our camps on the gravel & sand banks of the lake and river. Wildlife is quite common in the area, we travel through and one can expect to see black bear, moose, bald eagles and more.

Good fishing is to be expected throughout the trip and all meals are prepared on open camp fires and a choice of fresh trout, pike or grayling often feature on the menu.

Itinerary

Day 1: Whitehorse

Arrive independently, check into your hotel and join your guide in the evening for an orientation meeting.

Days 2-7: Whitehorse to Carmacks

We leave Whitehorse and canoe over 300km towards Carmacks via Lake Laberge where some shoreline paddling is required. Afterwards the river narrows and winds through great scenery with good fishing and passes interesting historical sites such as the old trading post of Hootalinqua and it's RNWMP outpost. Paddling on to the confluences of the Teslin and Big Salmon Rivers where wildlife, including black bears and moose, are often seen.

Day 8: Carmacks to Whitehorse

After breakfast we arrive at the small native village of Carmacks, which was founded by Klondike Goldrush co-discoverer, George Carmack and return to Whitehorse by road where your adventure ends on arrival.

Trip difficulty

A background in camping and paddling is an asset but not essential and, being current assisted, it is especially suitable for beginners.

Package includes

- Qualified guide throughout the trip
- Canoes and camping equipment
- Overland transportation
- 2 person tents (20 nights)
- Entrance fees for national parks
- 1 night pre trip hotel in Whitehorse
- Airport Shuttle in Whitehorse

Not included: Meals in hotels, Personal expenses, Gratuities

Tour cost & departures

Small group departure: Minimum 3/ Maximum 12 passengers per trip

Cost per person twin share from \$1,690

Departs: 5 Departures from June to August.
