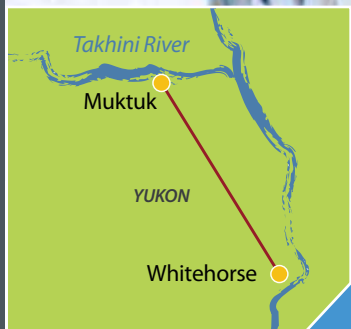

LEARN DOG SLEDDING & SEE THE NORTHERN LIGHTS  
2 FOR 1 YUKON WINTER ADVENTURE

Muktuk Ranch



Located on over 100 acres in the pristine wilderness of IbeX Valley close to the Takahini River and hot springs ~ 20mins by road from Whitehorse in a premium Northern Lights viewing area with panoramic vistas of the Laberge and Haeckel hills.

This is ideal country for winter activities especially dog sledding where the frozen rivers double as highways making it easy for beginners to learn the basics.

7 Day Beginners Dog Sledding Tour  
7 days/6 nights ex Whitehorse return trip



**Day 1: Whitehorse – Ranch**  
Arrive Whitehorse independently with a ~4.00pm transfer to the ranch for the next 6 nights stay and where the location offers spectacular Northern Lights viewing.

**Day 2: Dog Sledding**  
After breakfast meet your dogs for the first time and your guide will begin to teach the basics of harnessing and dog mushing so that by the afternoon you are ready to head out for your first run.



**Day 3: Dog Sledding**

A full day on a beginners trail with a picnic lunch around a camp fire.

**Day 4: Activity day**

Today a change of pace from mushing where you can choose from a selection of other included activities such as a half-day ice-fishing, snow shoeing and hiking the ridge overlooking the IbeX

Valley and Takhini River. Optional day tours at extra cost include a visit to the Yukon Wildlife Preserve and Hot Springs or a snowmobile adventure.

**Days 5-6: Dog Sledding**

As your skills improve enjoy 2 more days sledding on different and more challenging scenic trails with a farewell "Taste of the Yukon" dinner Day 6 at which you will be presented with your dog mushing certificate.

**Day 7: Ranch-Whitehorse**

Say farewell to your dogs before a transfer to Whitehorse to your hotel or onward flight.

Departs: Saturday & Wednesdays from mid November to mid April
