**Filled with fun and adventure** this trip is for the outdoor enthusiast who wants to experience the true north in both the traditional and modern way of transportation.

Spend 3 days on snow machine (2 people per machine) some of the most spectacular landscapes the Yukon has to offer. Then step back in time and try your hand at the traditional transportation of the north. Spend your days mushing your own team (one person per dog sled) through the pristine wilderness of the Fish Lake area.

Relax in the evenings with a shower, sauna or snuggled up by the fire recounting your day's adventure with others on your tour! All you need bring is your sense of adventure and also be in relatively good physical shape!

## 8 DAY/7 NIGHT DOG SLEDDING & SNOW MOBILE ADVENTURE

### Itinerary:

#### Day 1: Modern - Its Snowmobile Time!

Meet your guide in Whitehorse and transfer out to the wilderness lodge overlooking picturesque Fish Lake. Upon arrival move into your cozy room in the main lodge/cabin/yurt. After lunch you head its time for orientation before heading out exploring the trails in the area. A wonderful dinner awaits your return in the lodge and if you're lucky, a chance to see the Northern Lights, as they dance across the sky (L,D)

#### Day 2

After a hearty breakfast, head out with your guide to start your morning snowmobile tour around Fish Lake. Return to the Yurt Bsecamp for lunch. Spend the afternoon exploring a new trail before finishing in time for a Yukon style dinner in the lodge, the evening is at leisure however, don't forget to look outside occasionally, perhaps the magical Aurora will make another appearance tonight? overnight at lodge (B,L,D).

#### Day 3

Another day of snowmobiling finds out you out on the trail for the whole day, traverse through the boreal forest and subalpine terrain, have your cameras at the ready as the scenery is breathtaking, lunch is on the trail and at the end of the day head back to the comfort and warmth of the lodge. (B,L,D)

#### Day 4: Traditional - It's Dog Sledding Time!!

Now experience traditional travel by dog sled! After breakfast you will meet your four legged companions, learn the basics of dog care, checking their feet and shoulders, dog massage, sledding and parts of the sled. Harness your team, hook up and go for your very first run! Take in the untouched beauty of the northern wilderness. Lunch on the trail. At the end of the day after taking care of the dogs, cleaning and feeding we can enjoy the sauna, have a shower, hot dinner and cozy up by the fire. (B,L,D)

#### Day 5

An early start today sees you enjoy a hearty breakfast and prepare your canine companions for the day ahead, as our destination is secluded Jackson Lake. The only sound will be the runners in the snow, the working dogs, and your words of encouragement. This is the day that you begin to know each dog's personality and form a bond that only man and dog can understand. With every stop, praise and show of affection for your dogs, they will learn to trust you and you to trust them. Relax in our sod roof sauna before retiring for the night. (B,L,D)

#### Day 6

Today your team will pull you east of the ranch. As we climb in elevation we are heading onto an old abandoned mining road on McIntyre Mountain. Enjoy the rugged landscape of the coastal mountains nestling Fish Lake in its valley. Keep an eye out for wildlife - you never know what you might see! Take care of the dogs, then curl up by the fire or sit around the dinner table recounting your adventures with others. (B,L,D)

#### Day 7

This day takes us towards beautiful Bonneville Lakes, west of the ranch. The scenery is breathtaking and the coastal mountains are always in view to the south and west. Part of the trip we are above tree line and easily cover 20-30km. A breath of new life will creep slowly into your soul and in harmony with the running rhythm of your team you will enjoy nature like you have never experienced it before. Take it all in and these memories will go with you as you continue your journey home. Late this afternoon we drive you to Whitehorse where you spend your last night at the Best Western Gold Rush Inn. Here you will receive your musher's diploma. (B,L)
