During the Fall, daylight soft adventure activities such as guided hiking, canoeing and fishing are offered. Come Winter, your soft adventure activities can include snow shoeing, dog sledding, ice fishing and snowmobile. At night when the "lights" come out to dance you can sit back on your private deck to watch this magical experience.

Blachford Lake Lodge

4 days/3 nights from Yellowknife

Includes: Return light plane from Yellowknife, accommodation, all meals, Summer scheduled activities- kayaking, canoeing, 2 hour fishing, motorized boat trips. Winter scheduled activities - skiing, snowshoes, fat bikes, ice fishing, ice skates, taxes included.

Open year round and only accessible by light plane from Yellowknife, here you will find a wilderness retreat for all seasons. Perched high on rocky knoll overlooking the lake and pristine wilderness, the lodge offers something for all seasons. Summer leads to guided walking and hiking, canoeing, fishing, overnight camping and wildlife spotting. The coming of Autumn brings the magic of the

Aurora, located at 62 degrees north and with a purpose-built viewing platform. Summer Aurora & Winter Aurora viewing is from mid-December through to mid-April. During Winter in addition to viewing the lights enjoy a myriad of activities such as ice fishing, fat biking, snowshoeing, cross country skiing, igloo building to name a few.





Boréale Ranch

4 days/3 nights 30 minutes by road from Whitehorse

Surrounded by wilderness this luxury ranch features large dining and lounge areas with fireplaces and huge windows looking out over the Coastal Mountain Range. Choose to stay in the main lodge or one of the detached suites all have private bathrooms and views.

Day 1: Boréale Ranch

Arrive Whitehorse and transfer to the lodge. Aurora viewing this evening. (D)

Days 2-3: Aurora Viewing

Relax at the lodge during the day or ask about the many activities available. Aurora Viewing each evening. (BLD)

Day 4: Depart Whitehorse

Transfer to the airport. (B)

Bettles Lodge

3 days/2 nights Located Brooks Range – 1 hour scenic flight from Fairbanks

Just 35 miles north of the Arctic Circle in one of the last true pristine wilderness areas in the world and sitting directly under the Auroral Band which means the highest Aurora activity in the Northern Hemisphere, with clear nights, no light pollution, Bettles Lodge is known for spectacular Aurora viewing.

Open year round, the Northern Lights can be seen from late August through to mid-April, the lodge offers tailored seasonal activities. The Historic Main lodge houses the bar, lounge and dining rooms, also six cosy rooms with shared bathrooms. For a touch of luxury choose to stay at the Aurora Lodge, the rooms feature jacuzzi bath tub, relax in wood fired sauna, or truly escape and stay in one of the private Wilderness Cabins.

Day 1: Fairbanks – Bettles Lodge

Board your scheduled flight today, this scenic 1 hour flight will take you over the Yukon River and above the Arctic Circle. Check into the lodge for the next two nights, enjoy the facilities of the lodge. Aurora viewing can be done from your lodge or at the Aurora Viewing cabin.

Day 2: Bettles Lodge

A tour of Bettles is included today, you are then free to enjoy seasonal included and optional activities at the lodge.

Day 3: Bettles Lodge – Fairbanks.

Fly back to Fairbanks where your tour ends on arrival. Longer stays with multi activity packages for all seasons available on request.

Muktuk Guest Ranch

4 days/3 nights Located 30 minutes by road from Whitehorse

Muktuk ranch sits on 86 acres nestled in the Ibx Valley. The views are thanks to our location on the Takhini River amid the untouched beauty of Laberge and Haeckel Hills, simply breathtaking no matter which direction you look. You will share the ranch with 125 adorable Huskies, a mixture of retirees, huskies in training for the Yukon Quest and pups who are ready to head out on the trail for a day of dog sledding with guests that come from all over the world.

The classic two-storey Main Lodge has four guest rooms, and is the main hub of the lodge life, with dining hall, lounge and sitting areas. There are also two cabins which can accommodate families as well.

Day 1: Whitehorse – Muktuk Ranch

Transfer from the airport or downtown to the ranch.

Days 2-3: Muktuk Ranch

Over the next two full days in addition to Aurora viewing in the evening, we have included activities which will vary depending on the season you travel.

Day 4: Muktuk Ranch – Whitehorse

Transfer to the airport or downtown.
