Days 1-2: Denver

Included during your stay is a Discover Denver Tour, highlights include the US Mint, Historic Larimer Square and the 16th Street Mall.

Day 3: Denver – Cheyenne

Wyoming's capital is considered the nation's railroad capital and well-known for its rodeos.

Day 4: Cheyenne – Bodlands National Park

Explore the rugged beauty of the Badlands, look for bison, bighorn sheep, and prairie dogs throughout its praries.

Day 5: Badlands NP – Mt Rushmore – Rapid City

Visit Mount Rushmore, located in the Black Hills.

Day 6: Rapid City – Cody

Cody is known as the rodeo capital of the world. Attend rodeo shows, visit the world-class Buffalo Bill Center of the West and cowboy experiences

Day 7: Cody/Yellowstone National Park

Discover the world's first national park containing more than two million acres of crystalline lakes, thundering waterfalls, panoramic vistas and steaming geysers including "Old Faithful".

Day 8: Cody – Jackson

Continue to explore Yellowstone and then head to Jackson for a two night stay. Day 9 Jackson

Day 9: Jackson – Grand Teton National Park

Explore Grand Teton National Park's over two hundred miles of trails, float the Snake River or enjoy the serenity of pristine lakes and alpine terrain.

Day 10: Jackson – Salt Lake City

Explore Temple Square, home to nearly 20 attractions related to the Mormon church such as the Salt Lake Temple and the Mormon Tabernacle.

Day 11 Salt Lake City – Arches NP – Moab

Visit Arches National Park, the site of more than 2,000 natural sandstone arches.

Day 12: Moab – Canyonlands National Park

At Canyonlands National Park discover thousands of square miles of colorful canyons, mesas and buttes. Late this afternoon enjoy a Sunset Boat cruise with dinner (included)

Day 13: Moab – Mesa Verde – Durango

Visit Mesa Verde National Park known for its well-preserved Ancestral Puebloan cliff dwellings.

Day 14: Durango

Ride the historic Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad through the stunning San Juan National Forest.

Day 15: Durango – Colorado Springs

En route, visit Great Sand Dunes National Park.

Day 16: Colorado Springs – Denver

Your journey ends upon arrival in Denver.
