Some activities are weather dependent and seasonal.

Day 1: Montreal

You will be met at the airport and transfer by private SUV to your 5 star hotel located in Old Montreal.

Day 2-3: Montreal

Discover the city, enjoy a private guided walking tour of Old Montreal, highlights include the Place des Armes, Notre Dame Basilica, Bonsecours Market. See the city from the water as you cruise along the waterways by small boat. (B)

Day 4: Montreal

Seaplane to North Hatley Eastern Townships

Board your private seaplane for the 40 minute flight to the Eastern Townships village of North Hatley. The Eastern Townships are a collection of small towns and villages nestled in a extension of the Appalachian Mountains. The next 2 nights are spent at the luxurious Manoir Hovey a Relais & Chateaux historic retreat. (BD)

Day 5: Eastern Townships – The Orford Express

Board the private Orford Express train and treat yourself to a unique sensory experience – an exquisite meal all the while taking in the great pastoral views that sweep the countryside between Magog, Eastman, Sherbrooke & Bromont.. Choose either Brunch or Lunch – (3 ½ - 4 hours). With supplement you can choose to spend the day wine tasting in the winelands of the Eastern Township, 3 – 4 vineyards with time for tastings. (BD)

Day 6: North Hatley – Seaplane to Mauricie

Located between Montréal and Québec City the beautiful Mauricie Region awaits you! Fly by seaplane to your remote Auberge, here you will discover wide open space, forests, lakes and rivers, view wildlife, kayak or try your hand at fishing. Spend three nights at the Auberge du Lac l'Eau Claire. (BD)

Day 7: Bear & Beaver Watching

The day is at leisure to enjoy the activities offered by the lodge, late afternoon meet a local trapper and settle into

a cabin deep in the forest and enjoy an afternoon of bear watching. (BD)

Day 9: Mauricie By Seaplane to Charlevoix

Fly to Charlevoix and collect your rental car. Take the scenic route along the Saint Laurent river to Baie Saint Paul a UNESCO declared World Biosphere Reserve. From here you can discover the valley of Malbaie the crater of Charlevoix and the national parks. Hotel Le Germain Charlevoix (B)

Day 10 Charlevoix - Whale Watching in Tadoussac

Drive to Tadoussac and visit the Marine Centre then later in the afternoon board your boat for a 3 hour whale watching cruise. Drive back to Charlevoix. (B)

Day 11: Charlevoix – Québec City

A leisurely drive to Québec City, check into your hotel located in Old Québec. Auberge St Antoine. (B)

Day 12: Québec City

Explore the city at your leisure, or take one of our private tours such as a walking tour of Old Quebec. (B)

Day 13: Québec City – Visit Ile D'Orleans

Connected to the mainland by a bridge and only 20 minutes from the city centre, Ile d'Orleans is one of the first settlements of New France it is divided into 6 townships, the oldest established in 1661. It is home to historical homes, churches, vineyards, sugar shacks, bakeries and stunning scenery. The visit can be self drive or a private guided tour can be booked with supplement. (B)

Day 14: Depart Québec City

Your tour ends this morning. This is a private tour and can be adjusted to suit the individual traveller, call and speak to one of our destination experts!
