Day 1: Winnipeg

Check into your hotel and meet your fellow travellers and your guide at the welcome dinner. (D)

Day 2 & Day 3: Via Rail to Churchill

Board the train for the two night journey north, dinner on board then settle into your comfortable berth for the night. In the morning wake up to a snow- covered landscape of Manitoba. Spend the day relaxing and meeting with the many local people who live in the remote communities and about life off-grid. (BLD)

Day 4: Arrive Churchill

The train arrives in the morning after disembarking enjoy a tour of the town, check into your hotel and after lunch, head out to meet huskies & a local dog musher, go dog sledding then back to the hotel. (BLD)

Day 5: Churchill – Tundra Buggy Adventure

Board the Tundra Buggy for a day out on the tundra viewing Polar Bears. (BLD)

Day 6: Churchill

Visit the Itsanitq Museum, home to 1000 pieces of Inuit art dating back from the 1700BC through to modern times & visit Parks Canada Visitor Centre. (BLD)

Day 7: Churchill – Tundra Buggy Adventure - Winnipeg

Board the Tundra Buggy for a day out on the tundra viewing Polar Bears, then late in the afternoon board your flight to Winnipeg. (BLD)

Day 8 Depart Winnipeg

Take the shuttle to the airport
